

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.1. uFit is an automatically renewable subscription-based service that provides users with access to electronic content through applications designed for the Android platform, subject to a daily subscription fee.

1.1.1. The download and use of such content are not limited. A subscribed user may download an unlimited number of applications, subject only to the available storage capacity of the user's mobile device.

1.2. All content downloaded through the uFit service is not owned by Ucom CJSC (hereinafter referred to as "Ucom") and is provided by third-party developers. Accordingly, Ucom shall not be liable for the integrity, functionality, performance, or security of the applications, nor for any permissions granted by the user when accessing or using the content.

1.3. The user acknowledges that, in order to download and use applications through uFit, a mobile device compatible with Android technology and running Android version 2.3 or higher is required.

1.3.1. The user further acknowledges that the use of the uFit service and its content requires an Internet connection, including but not limited to Wi-Fi, GPRS, EDGE, 3G, 4G, or other available data connection technologies. Offline use is limited to five (5) application launches without an active Internet connection.

1.4. By subscribing to the service, the user acknowledges and agrees that all applicable charges shall be payable regardless of whether the user's device meets the technical compatibility requirements. Ucom shall not provide refunds where the service is unavailable or cannot be used due to device incompatibility.

1.5. Any costs related to Internet access and data traffic generated while using the service shall be charged to the user in accordance with the tariffs of the user's mobile network operator. Ucom may, at its sole discretion, temporarily exempt the user from data traffic charges related to content downloads. The user acknowledges that such exemption may be withdrawn at any time.

1.6. To subscribe to the service, the user must be of legal age or must have the appropriate consent of a parent or legal guardian.

1.6.1. Where the service is accessed, used, or purchased by a minor, responsibility shall rest with the subscriber in whose name the mobile number is registered. Such subscriber shall be deemed to have authorized the minor's use of the service. Ucom shall not be liable for improper use of the applications or for accidental

purchases. Full responsibility for the possession, control, and use of the mobile device required to access the service shall remain with the legal guardian or contracting party.

1.7. Ucom shall not be liable for the user's inability to connect to the Internet, for issues related to the use of hardware or software, or for the availability of third-party services, websites, or links. The user acknowledges that Ucom does not warrant that the service will meet the user's expectations or specific requirements.

1.8. Ucom shall not be liable for the content of advertisements, banners, pop-up windows, or any other advertising formats displayed on websites or in third-party applications accessible through the service. Responsibility for such content rests solely with the respective advertiser.

1.9. The user acknowledges that, due to the nature of the service, Ucom cannot guarantee that the service will operate continuously, without interruption, or free from errors.

1.10. Ucom shall not be liable for any damage or loss suffered by the user as a result of accessing fraudulent or imitation websites that resemble the official pages of the service.

1.11. The user acknowledges that under no circumstances shall Ucom be liable for any damage or loss arising from:

- (i) the use or inability to use the service;
- (ii) the disclosure or sharing of personal data on social networks;
- (iii) unauthorized access to, transmission of, or alteration of data;
- (iv) actions or omissions of third parties;
- (v) force majeure events or actions performed by the user.

1.12. Ucom shall not refund any amounts charged to the user in the following cases:

- (i) incompatibility of the user's hardware or software with the service;
- (ii) failure of the user's device to meet the minimum technical requirements;
- (iii) errors or incorrect actions attributable to the user;
- (iv) breach by the user of these terms and conditions;

(v) bad-faith conduct by the user;

(vi) cancellation or refusal of the service after its activation.

1.13. The user undertakes to comply with the rules governing the use of the service. Responsibility for the quality, accuracy, reliability, completeness, and compliance of the content rests solely with the relevant content owner or rights holder.

1.14. Ucom shall not be liable for any modification, replacement, removal, or withdrawal of applications or content providers from the service. The user acknowledges that such changes are an inherent part of the operation and management of the service.
